### Celebrating 65 years of conservation

The Warren Soil and Water Conservation District has been assisting both urban and rural individuals who share their concerns for the protection of the soil, water, and related natural resources in the county for 65 years this month.

Located at 909 E. Second Ave., Suite B in Indianola (515) 961-5264, the district is guided by five commissioners who are elected to four-year nonpartisan terms without salary.

As a legal subdivision of state government, the commissioners are responsible for carrying out state laws and programs concerning soil and water conservation within Warren County.
