

2022 RESOLUTIONS FINAL VOTING RESULTS 10-03-2022

NOTES:

- Per CDI Bylaws, a resolution must receive a minimum of 60% approve votes to be approved.
- Pre-conference voting results for 2022 were:
 - Nine resolutions were submitted for consideration.
 - 420 (83.8%) of Iowa's commissioners voted. All voting commissioners did not vote on all resolutions.
 - Resolution #2 was approved.
 - Resolutions #1, #6, #7, #8, and #9 failed.
 - Resolutions #3, #4, and #5 were forwarded to annual conference for discussion.
 - Three resolutions were identified for archiving; archiving was approved for each of the three.
- At Annual Conference:
 - Resolutions #3, #4, and #5 were discussed and voted upon.
 - 198 (39.6%) of Iowa's commissioners attended conference. All commissioners in attendance did not vote on all resolutions.
